### **Pierburg Building** (16-32 students)

The Pierburg Building and one acre Kauffman Gardens are designed to allow pupils to plant, harvest and explore how vegetables grow, while making links to the carbon footprint, sustainability and local produce.



### **Tamar Manoukian Outdoor Centre** (44 students)\*

This residential outdoor centre offers accommodation for 44 young people and up to 6 staff by day or overnight. Experience activities based on Leadership, Confidence Building, Archery, Bushcraft, Orienteering and Indoor Sports.



### **Kuanyshhev Traditional Skills Centre** (12 students)

Train under the Dumfries House Crafts Team to make a variety of items including bird boxes, picnic benches, and planters. Or try your hand at the Masons mark in our Stone masonry experience.

### **Dumfries House (16 - 32 Students)**

Experience the history, design and features of a Scottish Georgian Country House, planned and developed by the Adam brothers and furnished by Chippendale. A true time capsule of eighteenth century life.



### **Rural Skills (16-32 Students)**

Explore the development of rural skills on the Dumfries House Estate, through involvement in woodland management, woodland walk development and how biodiversity and the environment relate to the landscape.
